

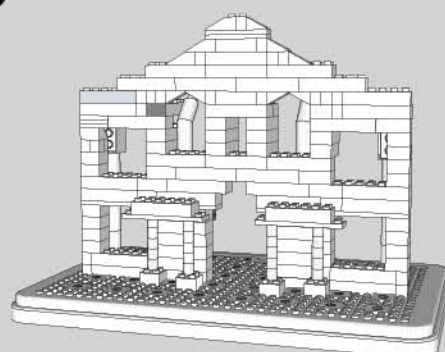
ALAMO: This 18th-century complex in San Antonio, Texas, saw one of the most memorable battles of the state's 1835 war for independence from Mexico. Originally named the Mission San Antonio de Valero, it came to be called the Alamo early in its history because of the cottonwood trees (known in Spanish as álamo) growing on its grounds.



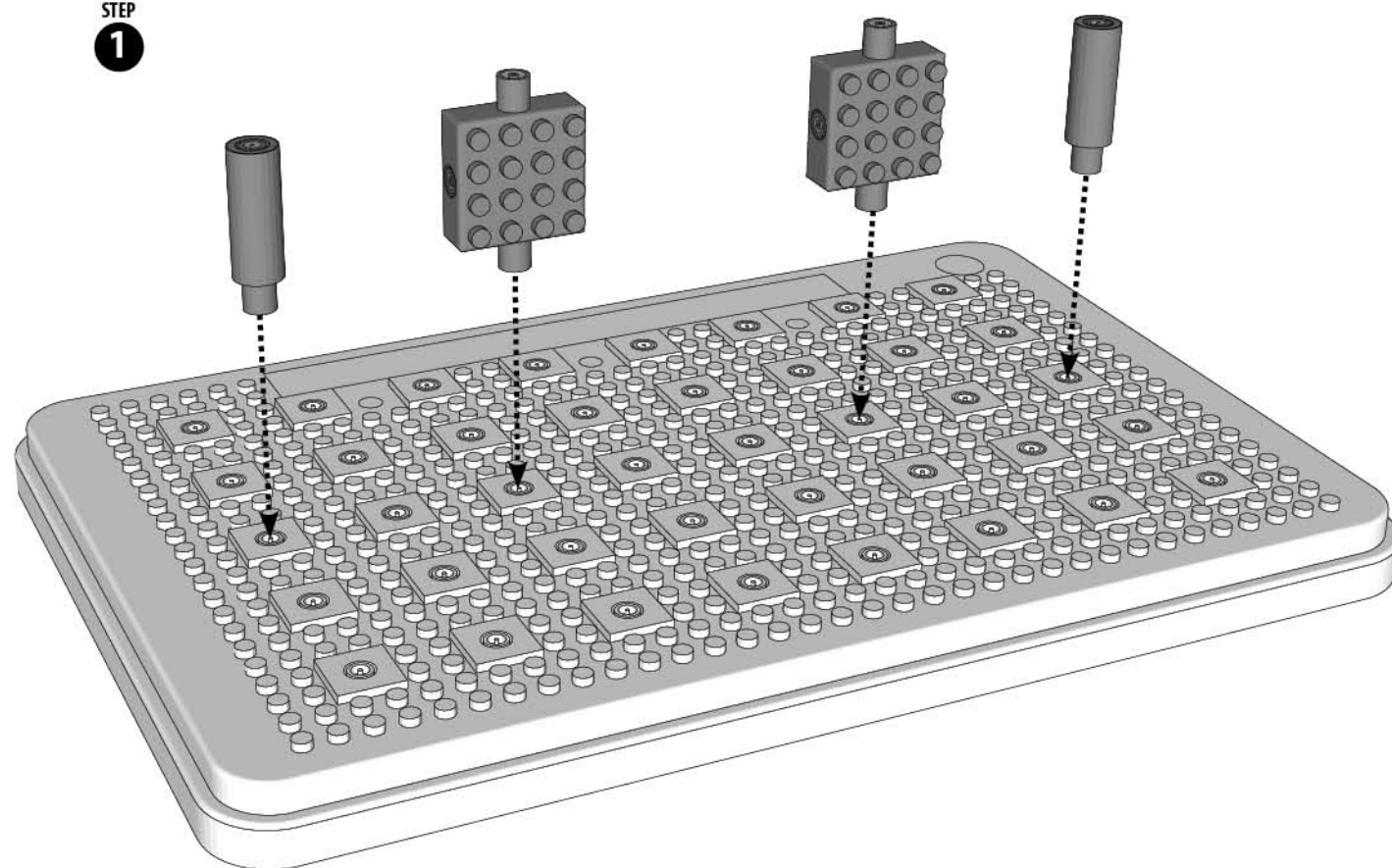
